She currently serves as an Executive Director of IABT, International Association of Black Triathletes, a 501C3 organization, headquartered in Baltimore, Maryland. It was under the expert guidance and leadership of Dr. Dorsey’s that IABT launched their first ever African American Junior MultiSport Club three years back, which is geared towards low and moderate income, under-served and under-represented communities that operate out of Baltimore. This Junior MultiSport Club competes locally and on the national circuit as well.

Having developed successful leadership models and curriculums that remain the basis and foundation for many programs at different levels, she is now committed to share her knowledge of sports with the youngsters and encourage them to take up multi-disciplined sports for a complete all-round development. Her course takes a different approach to programs, activities, professional development, workshops, which can be

quite beneficial for the youth who comes from moderately poor families to gain college access and scholarships.

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
